Greater Cleveland Food Bank

Since 1997, St. Mary of Egypt has been able to provide nearly **800,000 lbs.** of food to those in need. Canned goods, staple foods, frozen meats, fresh fruits and vegetables, breads, pastries, beverages, and personal care products are purchased as available from the GCFB for the Mission's local distributions. Each month, St. Mary of Egypt purchases pallets full of food (several thousands of pounds) from the Food Bank, which delivers the pallets to our distribution center for a modest charge. In addition to these regular orders, our volunteers visit the Food Bank's **MarketPlace** to shop for extra goods.

The GCFB plays a significant role in supervising our outreach program:

- The Food Bank **has standards for quality** of all items, food and non-food, that they distribute. Their central facilities pass regular inspections by the Ohio Dept. of Job & Family Services, Feeding America and the USDA.
- In turn, they set standards for maintenance of their agencies' facilities (like year-round climate control) and ask their pantries to distribute purchased food in 90 days.
- The Food Bank holds **regular site visits** to inspect our facility and ensures our compliance with federal regulations of the distribution of aid.
- The Food Bank **maintains records** and provides statistics of how many individuals and families were served from our outreach program and how many pounds of food were provided each year. They report back to the Mission whether we are meeting Food Bank expectations for pounds per person delivered.
- GCFB member agencies benefit from the Food Bank's education initiatives through various workshops held during the year. Volunteers learn about food safety and nutrition, receive training on client relations, and take classes on program management.
